

Obregon Family Support Letter

December 15, 2006

Dear Family and Friends:

This year it has been estimated that in Papua New Guinea (PNG) there are over 5.5 million people. Over the last few years, Victor and I have had the privilege of going to PNG to serve on several short-tem medical and evangelistic outreaches. While there, we strongly sensed God's heart and compassion for the people. Together with the churches, we rejoiced in all that God was already doing there. But as we established relationships with the people of PNG, we noted that there still exists for many a deep longing, pain, and desperate need that only the light and the truth of the gospel could satisfy.

For some time now, we have felt a call from God to go and live in PNG so that we could help and support the kingdom work there. *We have some wonderful news to share with you.* We have been accepted by Foursquare Missions International to serve as Missions Interns (individuals called by God to serve in many capacities overseas) to PNG beginning January 1, 2007.

Our older son, Nathan, will stay here as he is still in school. Our 11 year old son, Alex, will of course come with us to PNG. We plan to live and serve as a family utilizing our medical training as medical doctor and registered nurse. While serving there, we also plan to utilize our ministry training and our own life experiences of having God fill our deep longings with the truth of His love. In addition to coming alongside the PNG national Foursquare church in any way we can, our duties will also include assisting Foursquare Missions Associates Keith and Cindy Bickley with the New Guinea Islands (NGI) Leadership Training Institute, teaching at the NGI Foursquare Bible College, and participating in medical and evangelistic outreaches to the local and the more remote island areas of East New Britain, New Ireland, and nearby Bougainville.

Will you consider being involved in this endeavor with us? First, we would ask that you pray for us. We will be going to a different culture and will have many adjustments to make, not to mention all the changes involved with transitioning out of our medical practice here and the many details that need to be completed. Also, we would ask that you pray that God will prepare the way ahead of us so that not only will the people respond to the gospel and find salvation and healing, but that they would come to lean on and trust in the One and Only Jesus, God with us, and be filled with the Holy Spirit.

Our initial call is to serve one year with the option of one or two more additional years. If God is leading you to support this ministry financially, please use the information below to facilitate your giving. Our monthly expenses are estimated to be \$2300. One-time expenses would include airfare \$7800, insurance \$2000, initial purchase of materials and supplies \$4000, and a possible used vehicle purchase of \$10,000.

Thank you for your time and prayerful consideration of partnering with us to build and encourage God's kingdom in Papua New Guinea.
